- Councillors vote to stop budget cuts to bus subsidies and gritting routes
- The Environment, Development and Transport Committee (EDT) have voted to stop any budget cuts to bus subsidies and gritting routes.
- Children's Services in Norfolk no longer require intervention and the County Council's adoption service is outstanding, Ofsted has found in its latest inspection.
- The County Council has confirmed its zero tolerance approach to bullying and harassment and revealed that two employees have been dismissed for this issue over the last two years.
- Norfolk County Council's staff and contractors received a lot of praise for the huge effort to clear 160 trees from roads following the storms last week.
- The Communities Committee voted unanimously on Wednesday 17 January to recommend to the Police and Crime Commissioner that Norfolk Fire and Rescue Service should continue to be governed by Norfolk County Council rather than move under control on the PCC
- Partners from five European countries have come together as part of a €1.2m green pilgrimage project which aims to make the most of increasingly popular routes and destinations.
- The Digital Innovation and Efficiency
 Committee had representatives from the
 four largest mobile phone companies at our
 meeting yesterday and they outlined their
 plans for improving coverage in Norfolk.
 The importance of providing fibre data
 connections to new houses as they are
 being built was also discussed.
