Proposed Roundabout

We received the following communication from Norfolk County Council regarding the proposed roundabout...

Norfolk County Council will be holding a public consultation on proposals to replace the existing crossroads between B1146 Hempton Road and C550 Dereham Road with a four-arm roundabout. The consultation will be held to understand the views about the proposed scheme and take these into consideration before a planning application is submitted. The consultation will run from 17th May until the 6th June 2021 and the consultation will be run online from Norfolk County Council's consultation hub. Residents and businesses close to the crossroads will be written to, to let them know about the consultation and will provide a telephone number for anyone without internet access.

The proposed roundabout will improve safety and reduce congestion where the junction has seen an excessive number of crashes in recent years. Footways and pedestrian crossings are also included within the proposed design.

We haven't seen much progress on any of our projects so will update you further next month.

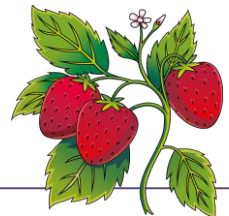

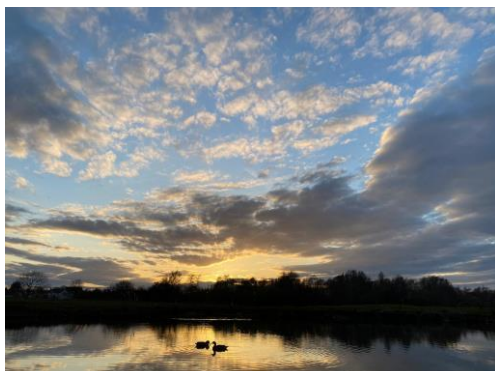
